What data do we collect?

Technical Elements Ltd collects the following data:

How do we collect your data?

You directly provide Technical Elements Ltd with most of the data we collect. We collect data and process data when you:

- Voluntarily complete a customer survey or provide feedback on any of our message boards or via email.
- Use or view our website via your browser's cookies.
- Engage our services as a technical support company.

Technical Elements Ltd may also receive your data indirectly from the following sources:

- Passed to us by the companies we support to provide digital virtual conference events.

What are your data protection rights?

Technical Elements Ltd would like to make sure you are fully aware of all of your data protection rights. Every user is entitled to the following:

The right to access - You have the right to request Technical Elements Ltd for copies of your personal data. We may charge you a small fee for this service.

The right to rectification - You have the right to request that Technical Elements Ltd correct any information you believe is inaccurate. You also have the right to request Technical Elements Ltd to complete information you believe is incomplete.

The right to erasure – You have the right to request that Technical Elements Ltd erase your personal data, under certain conditions.

The right to restrict processing - You have the right to request that Technical Elements Ltd restrict the processing of your personal data, under certain conditions.

The right to object to processing - You have the right to object to Technical Elements Ltd processing of your personal data, under certain conditions.

The right to data portability - You have the right to request that Technical Elements Ltd transfer the data that we have collected to another organisation, or directly to you, under certain conditions.
